First Name Last Name, *Title* (Publication City: Publisher, Year Published), Page

Subsequent Footnotes or Endnotes

Last Name, *Shortened Version of Title*, page.

Hemingway, *The Old Man*, 23.

Bibliographical Entry

Last Name, First Name. *Title*. Publication City: Publisher, Year Published.

Hemingway, Ernest. *The Old Man and the Sea*. New York City: Scribner, 1995.

Two or More Authors

Footnote or Endnote

First Name Last Name and First Name Last Name, *Title* (Publication City: Publisher, Year Published), Page.

Amy Stechler Burns and Ken Burns, *The Shakers: Hands to Work, Hearts to God* (New York: Random House, 1990), 24.

Subsequent Footnotes or Endnotes

Last Name and Last Name, *Shortened Version of Title*, page.

Burns and Burns, *The Shakers*, 27.

Bibliographical Entry

Last Name, First Name, and First Name Last Name. *Title*. Publication City: Publisher, Year Published.

Burns, Amy Stechler and Ken Burns. *The Shakers: Hands to Work, Hearts to God*. New York: Random House, 1990.

Note: For four or more authors, in the note write only the name of the first author followed by "et al" (Johnson et al) and then list all the authors in the bibliography.

First Footnote or Endnote

First Name Last Name, "Article, Source, or Chapter Title" in *Book Title*, ed. Editor First Name Editor Last Name (City of Publication: Publisher, Year), Page.

John Adams, "Thoughts on Government" in *The American Republic: Primary Sources*, ed. Bruce Frohnen (Indianapolis: Liberty Fund, 2002), 222.

Subsequent Footnotes or Endnotes

Last Name, "Shortened Title," Page.

Adams, "Thoughts on Government," 222.

Bibliographical Entry

Last Name, First Name. "Article, Source, or Chapter Title." In *Book Title*, edited by Editor First Name Editor Last Name, Pages of Article, Source, or Chapter Title. City of Publication: Publisher, Year.

Adams, John. "Thoughts on Government." In *The American Republic: Primary Sources*, edited by Bruce Frohnen, 222-230. Indianapolis: Liberty Fund, 2002.

Online Journal Article

Footnote or Endnote

First Name Last Name, "Article Title," *Journal Title* Vol. No. (Year): page, date of access, Digital Object Identifier or URL.

Websites

First Footnote or Endnote

First Name Last Name, "Title of Web Page," *Publishing Organization or Name of Website*, publication date and/or access date if available, URL.
